Big Time

Big Time, DK, 2017, documentary, 93 min

According to The Wall Street Journal Bjarke Ingels has "rapidly become one of the design world's biggest stars," and his name recently appeared in TIME'S 100 Most Influential People. The film is an intimate insight into the life of a genius' innovative mind and his struggle to maintain his own persona while making the world a better place to live. It follows star architect Bjarke Ingels over a period of six years as he struggles to complete his largest projects yet, the New York skyscraper W57 and World Trade Center 2.

Darling

Darling, DK, 2017, drama, 103 min

Darling is the moving love story about a ballet dancer on the rollercoaster of her life, a drama about the rise and fall of a modern woman as she summons up the courage to face her greatest trial.

Denmark '92

Sommeren '92, DK, 2015, sport/drama/comedy, 93 min

In 1992, the Danish national football team had failed to qualify for the European Championship in Sweden. The players were already on holiday when they were called up in their summer residences with a surprising message: Yugoslavia was disqualified because of the war, and the Danes were set to replace them. The rest is history: Denmark went on to surprise the experts and upset the odds by winning the tournament, beating the reigning European and World Champions in the process.

Eventyrland

Eventyrland, NO, 2013, drama, 93 min

During a burglary Jenny tells her boyfriend Frank that she is pregnant. Frank proposes to her on the spot. The burglary goes down badly: instead of a small bag of marijuana they were looking for, they find several kilos of heroin. In the gunfight that ensues, Jenny shoots two people. One of them is Frank. After serving 10 years in prison for murder, Jenny returns to society. She wants to live a quiet life and resume her responsibilities as a mother, but soon shadows from the past start to appear.

Going West

Rett vest, No, 2018, drama/comedy, 83 min

An unemployed music teacher takes his estranged transgender father on a road trip to the west coast of Norway, in order to honor his late mother's excellent quilting skills. Going West is a warm and touching feelgood film about life, loss and love.

Heavy Trip

Hevi reissu, FI, 2018, comedy, 92 min

Turo, 25, tries to lead the worst heavy band ever in Finland, Impaled Rektum, to the hottest metal festival in Norway. Their journey includes metal music, vomiting, grave robberies, fake vikings and the first ever armed conflict between Finland and Norway.

Holly Mess

En underbar jävla jul, SE, 2016, comedy, 109 min

A gay couple invites their somewhat homophobic families to meet for the first time during Christmas celebration. And they have a special gift in store for them.

I am Yours

Jeg er din, NO, 2013, drama, 98 min

Mina is a young single mother living in Oslo with her 6 year old son Felix. She is of Norwegian Pakistani descent with a troubled family relationship. Constantly looking for love, Mina seeks affections from the men she hooks up with. However, none of the relationships bear any hope of lasting very long. So when Mina meets Jesper, a Swedish film director, she falls head over heels in love.

Limbo

Limbo, NO/SE, 2010, drama, 105 min

Direct from the Norwegian reality of the seventies, Sonia and her two children arrive in Trinidad to join her husband, Jo, who is working as an oil engineer. She is introduced to a homeless class of men who have the whole world as their workplace - and their wives, who follow them wherever their contracts take them. On the surface these women live lives of luxury, with large houses and servants. The days are uneventful and blend together into an everlasting holiday, where the women nurse their superficial relationships over poolside cocktails - the perfect climate for self-delusion.

Long Story Short

Lang historie kort, 2015, comedy/drama, 90 min

Long Story Short is the story of Ellen and her friends, all in their late thirties/early forties, and their more or less self-inflicted complications of love and longing for romantic redemption. The story is a summary of three years of love-related highs and lows for the group of friends told through eight chapters, each of them set at a party: a New Year's Eve, a house warming, a Midsummer's Eve, a wedding, a surprise party, a naming ceremony, an anniversary and a round birthday. It is an ensemble story about a group of people who struggle with the conception of the perfect relationship and are bound to re-evaluate their take on what true love is.

Mihkel

Mihkel, ISL, EST, 2018, thriller, 105 min

Seeking a better life in Iceland, Mihkel is presented with an opportunity by his childhood friend that could set him up for life. However, the deal comes with fatal consequences. Mihkel unwillingly becomes a drug mule to smuggle heroin across the border from Estonia into Iceland. But when it comes to retrieving their stash, things don't go quite according to plan.

Mongoland

Mongoland, NO, 2001, comedy, 84 min

After a half-year stay in England, Pia returns to Stavanger home for Christmas. She wants to meet her friend Kristoffer. When she gets to his apartment, she has an unpleasant surprise: Kristoffer disappears, and no one knows where he is.

Monsterthursday

Monstertorsdag, NO, 2004, drama/romantic, 103 min

A quirky romantic drama set in remote coastal Norway takes the viewer on a tumultuous ride through surfing aspirations, extreme weather and love.

My Future Love

Flykten till framtiden, SE, 2016, drama, 99 min

Stockholm, 1973. Svante has an incurable heart disease. One night, a strange subway train appears from nothing and takes him to 2016. In the future he meets Elsa. Together they must solve Svante's health problem and figure out how to live together although they come from two different eras.

Now It's Dark

Now It's Dark, NO, 2018, drama, 125 min

Lene catches her husband in bed at home with another woman. In shock, she escapes to the night, and goes on a new journey of life to which dream meetings are waiting, but also very dark moments. On her journey, she learns of the tragic events that led to her marriage crisis.

Owl Mountain

Peledu kalnas, LT, 2018, war, drama, 128 min

The drama tells about the political and social issues of Lithuania in 1947-1952. A student of one high school tries to collect various evidence demonstrating Kremlin crimes. His classmate, on the contrary, did not try to exploit and get rich by trading on the black market ...

Robin

Uro, DK, 2018, thriller, 87 min

A female-centric psychological thriller about Robin, who mysteriously awakens in a forest, naked and confused, and comes to the conviction, without any tangible evidence, she has witnessed a murder. Fearing the worst, she engages the police, but they too find nothing to back up her claim. As an internal anguish grows, and a puzzle-like, dream world becomes more real, she becomes more isolated and frightened. The terror that plagues her is that the murderer is now coming after her. In order to prevent herself from becoming the next victim, she starts to investigate on her own, and as the rabbit hole gets deeper - the murderer getting closer and a real physical danger escalating - a larger truth looms: that the essence of her psychic trauma lies in her real world and her closest relationships.

Staying Alive

Staying Alive, NO, comedy, 2014, 83 min

The comedy Staying Alive is about Marianne 34 who discovers out of the blue that her boyfriend Hakon is having an affair with Frida, a young colleague who makes waffles at work every Friday. Supported by her best friend's revenge tips and wisdom, Marianne stumbles into her new life where she eventually discovers that coziness is overrated and having fun is what matters.

Stockholm Stories

Stockholm Stories, SE, 2013, drama, 97 min

Life paths of five people cross during a few rainy days in Stockholm. Young metropolitan writer Johan, obsessing over his theory on urban light and darkness. Preppy Douglas finds himself in love with the recently dumped and currently homeless Anna. Advertising professional Jessica is denied an adoption because she lacks friends. Workaholic Thomas is distracted from his position at the cabinet minister by a randomly sent love letter. How much light do we need to see each other? And how much darkness to dare to meet? You need to unplug to connect.

What Will People Say

Hva vil folk si, NO/SE, 2017, drama, 106 min

Sixteen year-old Nisha lives a double life. At home with her family she is the perfect Pakistani daughter, but when out with her friends, she is a normal Norwegian teenager. When her father catches her in bed with her boyfriend, Nisha's two worlds brutally collide. A gripping and moving story about growing up in between two cultures, identity and belonging, and the turbulent journey of love and despair between one teenage girl and her family.

While We Live

Mens vi lever, DK, 2017, drama, 98 min

Inspired by true events, the film follows four people in Northern Denmark and how their fates intertwine in a tragic accident.
